




Zoom Seminar

Although most REALTORS® are knowledgeable about protected classes, and the adverse actions that constitute fair housing violations, it is often subtle practices that invite fair housing liability that are often overlooked.

The GMAR is presenting this one-hour tune up on Fair Housing on Thursday, April 10th at 10:00 AM. Special guest presenter will be Alexia Smokler, an attorney and serves as staff executive to NAR's Fair Housing Policy Committee and writes and speaks regularly on fair housing issues to audiences around the country.
